Northeast Credit Union Foundation Hosts First Ever Nourish Event at Quarryside at Rock Row in Westbrook

Proceeds from the race to benefit the school, Safe Passage

WESTBROOK, MAINE- (September 28, 2023) ---Runners have begun to register for the finale race in the series of Nourish Network Maine Road Races sponsored by the Northeast Credit Union Foundation. The 5K event is open to both runners and walkers and scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 5 at Quarryside at Rock Row in Westbrook, Maine. At the conclusion of the event, runners and supporters will gather at the Lone Pine beer garden to celebrate at Rock Row's Quarryside. There will be free parking and free admission for anyone who wants to come and cheer on the participants along with a celebration at the finish with food trucks on hand.

In the spirit of advancing the Northeast Credit Union Foundation's mission to enrich and nourish the lives of others, each of the races will have a Maine-based beneficiary to which a portion of the funds raised will be donated. Proceeds from the November 5 event will go to Safe Passage, a school in Guatemala, headquartered in New Gloucester and founded by a graduate of Bowdoin College. Safe Passage seeks to bring hope, education and opportunity to children and families trying to make a living around one of the largest landfills in Central America.

"The Northeast Credit Union Foundation believes in supporting organizations who are doing their part to enrich and nourish the lives of others. We are excited to be the first event at Rock Row and partner with their extraordinary team to help amplify the Nourish Network Maine Road Race Series. This new series will not only benefit our Maine communities but will have a lasting impact on a global scale with the work we are doing with Safe Passage," stated Dan Raposa, Executive Director of the Northeast Credit

Union Foundation. "Whether folks support the race by participating, volunteering, fundraising, or donating to a participant, there are opportunities for everyone to join the movement and make a difference," Raposa added.
